## RECYCLING FOR LIVE CHRISTMAS TREES

Public Works will be accepting *real trees* to mulch December 27 through January 16. After removing all decorations, leave trees at the marked drop off spot at the south end of Town Hall (1614 S Bowen Road).

## PREPARING FOR WINTER WEATHER



Pipes and faucets with little or no insulation can freeze in as little as three hours when temperatures are 20° or lower. Prepare by disconnecting garden hoses and covering outdoor faucets with Styrofoam or heavy cloth covered by plastic. It's also a good idea to locate your main shut off valve (usually in a flower bed near the front of the house) so you can quickly turn off your home's water supply if a frozen pipe leaves you with a leak after the thaw.

## **KEEP PETS WARM**

Pets' cold tolerance varies based on coat, fat stores, activity, and health. At 45° young, old, or sick animals can be at risk. No animal should be left outdoors at 32° or lower. If it's too cold for you, it's too cold for them. Shorten walks, protect paws, and provide warm, dry beds protected from drafts. Don't use hay for bedding as it retains water. Use blankets or straw instead. **Call 817-617-3701 if** you're worried about an animal.



Keeping you and your family safe is important. And Knowing what is going on in the world around you is critical to maintaining that safety. Whether a tornade has formed near your home or a boil-water notice is issued for your area, it could be lifesawing to know that you need to take cation.

CodeRED is a notification service your public safety officials provide for you that alerts you to emergencies happening nearby, so you can stay informed and make decisions that will positively impact your wall-base.
