Please note the new date for this event is Saturday, April 29, from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Help keep Pantego - and your garage - beautiful by clearing out limbs and brush, bulky items like unwanted furniture, and general debris.

Household hazardous waste will also be accepted but often reaches capacity as early as 10:00 a.m. This includes items like batteries, paint, solvents, yard and pool chemicals, and other items that should never be disposed of in curbside trash due to their potential to pollute soil and groundwater.

This cleanup is for Pantego residents only and is 'first-come, first-served'. Please bring your driver's license. Staff will be on-hand to help unload items. The event will end at 1:00 p.m. (or earlier if the container reaches capacity).


ITEMS THAT CANNOT BE ACCEPTED:

- ⇒ Medical waste, pills, needles
- ⇒ Electronics and smoke detectors
- Tires of any size
- Ammunition, explosives, butane/propane cylinders
- Hazardous or regulated material (e.g., Freon appliances, asbestos, lead paint, and mercury thermostats)

Election Cancelled

The Town of Pantego will not have any items on the May 6, 2023 ballot as only one filing was received for each place:

MAYOR: RUSSELL S. BREWSTER PLACE 4: GREGG KIDD PLACE 5: JEFF BROWN

During a regular meeting held Monday, February 27, Council adopted Ordinance 2023-903, cancelling the May 6, 2023 election for the Town of Pantego and declaring the three unopposed candidates (above) duly elected. These candidates will be sworn in after Election Day passes.

Though the Town has canceled its election, registered voters in the Town of Pantego may still be eligible to vote on other items or races on this general election date. Once available, sample ballots can be viewed at gisit.tarrantcounty.com/TCVL/.
