Use the boxes to prioritize these contacts. For example, if the manager should be called first in an emergency, label them as 1. If they were unreachable, label the second option as 2 (etc.). Please understand that including a number here does not mean that it will be called. Once our department notifies someone listed here of the situation, that party is typically expected to take on the responsibility of notifying all others. **TIP:** Store dispatch's number as a contact in these phones so you know if we're calling: 817-274-2511.

CodeRED is a reverse 9-1-1 system that helps us keep you informed during emergencies or hazardous situations. Sometimes it's used for general information (e.g., mosquito spraying or event reminders). However, you can choose which types of updates to receive. If you'd prefer to set up and manage your own account, click on the scrolling message at the top of our website.
